Beginning of the Year Forms -

If you have not already done so please COMPLETE THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR ON-LINE FORMS IN DIGITAL ACADEMY ASAP!! ALL ON-LINE FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED BY FRIDAY, AUGUST 29, 2025

EdChoice Acceptance Forms - Please turn in EdChoice Acceptance Forms ASAP to the school office.

UNIFORMS - Kindergarten through 3rd grade girls wear the Jumper. 4th - 8th grade girls wear skirts. Girls may also wear the khaki or black pants as their uniform. 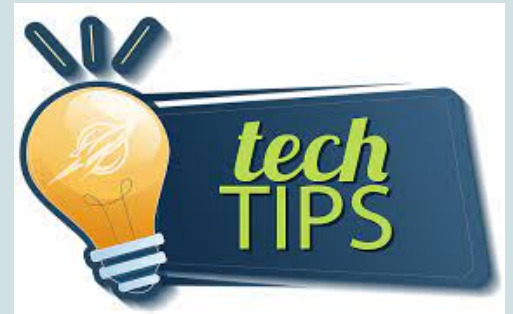
