Principally Speaking

Our teachers are enjoying a wonderful Teacher Appreciation week! If you have a minute, it would be nice if you wrote them a thank you as well!

This is just a reminder that we have an early dismissal (11:30AM) on Wednesday, May 13th with NO PM Bus service. Please make sure you figure out how your child(ren) will get home if they are bus riders.

We are getting to the busiest part of the year! Please make sure you are getting to school on time and ready to learn! It is the time of year where assessments are happening and attendance is vital! Let's finish the year strong!

We have invested in the security of our students and staff! The Archdiocese of Cincinnati is implementing a new safety system called RAPTOR. Any one who is passing through the office doors that lead into our building, will be considered a visitor and will need to register with your driver's license or state issued id at the main doors. Preschool parents that are dropping off at preschool will not be permitted to leave the preschool hallway and will need to come around to the main office doors for anything other than dropping off students. Once you are finished and come back to the office to sign out, you will give the office your visitor's pass to leave. This is for the safety of our students and staff while we are at school. If you have any questions, we will help!

If you have a new address or phone number, please notify the school office as soon as possible so we can update our records and ensure we are able to contact you if needed. If your address has changed, you must provide the office with a copy of a current Duke Energy or water bill showing the new address for verification. It is extremely important that we are always able to reach you during the day in case of an emergency. Not having a current, working phone number on file creates serious communication concerns and may prevent us from contacting you promptly when necessary.

Due to ongoing construction on Warsaw, traffic may be heavier than usual during morning drop off and afternoon pickup. Please allow yourself a little extra travel time to ensure your children arrive at school on time and are picked up promptly at the end of the day. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we navigate the delays together.

Please make sure you are regularly checking ClassDojo, as we use it to share important messages, reminders, and updates with families. Some communication from the school and teachers will be sent through Dojo, so checking it often will help you stay informed about what is going on at school. Thank you for helping us keep communication strong between home and school.

It is cold out and that means your child needs more than a sweatshirt when coming to school. WE WILL GO OUT FOR RECESS unless it is actively raining. Please send your child to school warmly dressed and with names in hats and gloves as well as coats!

We are requiring your child to have their badge and scan card for their lunch in the cafeteria. If they lose it, they will be required to pay \$3 to have it reprinted.

A reminder that at dismissal, students are not permitted to walk down Carson without an adult with them.

Attention Car Riders: When you exit you MUST turn left down Sturm. This helps keep the flow of traffic moving in the pick-up line.

Please ensure that your children are getting to school on time. Tardies will impact EdChoice! If your child will be absent or late, please call the school office in the morning to let them know.

Attention Alumni:

If you are in need of service hours or would like to come back and visit, we would love to see you! However, please note that prior approval is required before coming to the school. All visits must be approved in advance by Mrs. Long, Principal, as well as the teacher you will be spending time with. Thank you for helping us keep our school safe and organized—we look forward to welcoming you back!

Transportation Changes - REMINDER - all transportation changes MUST be called in before 2:15pm

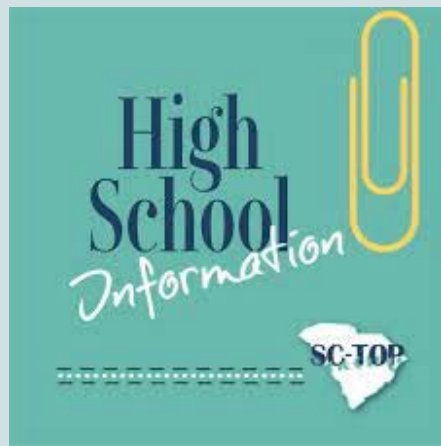
Dresscode - ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES ARE ALLOWED TO BE WORN DURING CLASS TIME!!!
